# How is the Trip:

Double occupancy accommodation, therefore, you will be sharing a room if traveling solo. Individual rooming can be arranged for an additional charge.

### **Important Policy:**

First payment to be completed by October 20th, 2024. First payment should be at least 50% of the value of trip to purchase flight ticket and insurance. The remaining balance is to be completed by March 20th, 2025. There is a 4% transaction fee for each transaction when paying with card. There is no transaction fee if transfer via Zelle.

From the confirmation of the reservation there is a cost of 150 dollars per passenger for travel management, which is not refundable.

Flights and Insurance are not refundable after purchase, but a claim can be made through the Insurance to obtain the flight refunded, if unable to travel, a copy of the policy will be provided for guidance.

Cancelations after May 20<sup>th</sup>, 2025, only 40% is of the package is refundable. No show is not refundable.

# **Activities Overview**

#### Osaka

Arrive in Osaka. Your friendly tour guide will be waiting at the airport to transfer you to the hotel. Enjoy the rest of the day at your own leisure.



#### Himeji

After breakfast, we take a guided tour of Himeji, located one hour from Osaka in Hyogo Prefecture. Himeji is world-famous for its magnificent castle, Himeji Castle and its beautifully arranged gardens. Himeji Castle is known as the White Heron Castle due to its elegant, white appearance and is widely



considered as Japan's most spectacular castle. It is listed as both a national treasure and a UNESCO World Heritage site. Continue on to Hiroshima for the night.

#### Hiroshima

Today, we begin with the Itsukushima Shrine on Miyajima Island. The shrine and its torii gate are unique for being built over water, seemingly floating in the sea during high tide. Then visit the Peace Memorial Park and Atomic Bomb Museum, which commemorates the victims of the atomic bomb used in WWII.







#### Nara – Kyoto

Visit Todaiji Temple, with its Great Buddha Hall housing the world's largest bronze statue of the Buddha Vairocana. Wander through Nara Park, where over 1,200 wild sika deer roam free. Then travel to Kyoto, visit Nijo Castle, the Kyoto residence of the Tokugawa Shogunate and Kinkakuji: Golden Pavilion, a Zen temple and World Heritage site with two floors covered entirely in thin layers of pure gold and detailed architecture incorporating three distinct architectural styles of Shinden, Samurai, and Zen..

#### **Kyoto**

Today, visit Togetsu Bridge, the landmark of Western Kyoto's Arashiyama District for over four hundred years. Explore Sagano Bamboo Forest

on the outskirts of Kyoto, where towering green stalks of the famously versatile plant sway in the wind, creaking eerily as they collide and twist, leaves rustling. After lunch, travel onwards to Mount Fuji by bullet train - Shinkansen (Max. speed 320km/h)..



#### Mt. Fuji

Today, visit Oshino Hakkai. Known as the Springs of Mount Fuji, the eight ponds are fed by melting snow filtering down from the slopes of nearby Mount Fuji through porous layers of lava, resulting in very

clear spring water that is revered by the



locals. Later visit Mount Fuji's 5th Station, which is above the clouds, to view its enormous summit if weather permits. (Alternatively, visit Gotemba Peace Park to capture a breathtaking view of Mount Fuji, and Hakone Checkpoint, which used to be an important checkpoint on the highway connecting Kyoto to Tokyo in the Edo period.) Take a cruise on Lake Ashi, and savour the numerous delights of nature.



#### Mt.Fuji - Tokyo

Today, visit a Japanese Beer Factory to taste one of the most popular Japanese beers on the way to Tokyo. Arrive in Tokyo, the rest of the day is at your own leisure.



#### Tokyo

Spend today free at your own leisure. You may spend a day in Tokyo Disneyland or DisneySea (admission \$120), or you can join the Nikko Day Tour. Or alternatively, you can join our wide range of optional programs (tea ceremony, potterymaking experience, golden joinery, kimono photo shoot, cooking class). All activities are not guided, and transportation is self-arranged. Next day after



checking out from the hotel, transfer to the airport to board your flight.
